Updates:

- ◆ Oct. 30, 31 Nov. 1 Mr. Rodriguez and his team of Mrs. Morris, Mrs. Lechner, Mrs. Bowser and Tracy. Did a wonderful job of organizing and administering the Fall AIMS test. We had over 300 juniors and seniors that took the test. Approximately 65 of them took it with the purpose of improving their scores from “Meets” to “Exceeds”.
- ◆ Those students that have not yet passed AIMS math have been assigned to a math teacher during their advisory time. During this time the students are given math tutoring to assist them with meeting the AZ Academic Standards.
- ◆ I met with the math department on Oct. 29 to help them strategize on AIMS strategies for assisting our students to meet the AZ Academic Standards in mathematics.
- ◆ Our Embrace-It club has designed 2 weeks worth of advisory activities centered on tolerance and diversity. They will be showing the video “A Place at the Table: Struggles for Equality in America,” and then hosting a lunch time *Mix It Up Day* where student are asked to sit with different students during lunch. The students will then be doing a follow-up survey.
- ◆ As the community is growing, I believe in keeping our teachers, administrators, security and parents informed of societal issues. Therefore I will be having a Detective from the Maricopa County Sheriff’s department present general information about gang characteristics and what to watch for in the schools and community. He will be presenting to both the faculty and to the Site-Council. The Town of Queen Creek nor Queen Creek High School have a gang problem however education is the best way to curb a future issue. The Detective will also be at QCHS during lunch one day to walk the campus and inform the administration and security of current student trends.
