Queen Creek Transportation Department Bus Rules and Regulations

In order to maintain a safe environment for all students while riding the bus, it is crucial for everyone to follow the rules below. The bus driver is the authority at all times, and students must adhere to their guidance.

Student Responsibilities:

- Bus Etiquette:
 - Keep the aisle clear of obstructions.
 - Keep the bus clean and free of litter.
- Punctuality & Safety:
 - Be on time for the bus, both in the morning and afternoon.
 - Stand **10 feet** away from the roadway while waiting for the bus.
- Boarding & Exiting the Bus:
 - Always use the steps and handrail when boarding or leaving the bus.
 - Enter and exit the bus in an orderly manner.
- Seating & Behavior:
 - Sit facing forward in assigned seats.
 - Remain seated while the bus is in motion.
 - \circ Talk in a normal tone; loud or vulgar language is not allowed.
- Bus Window Safety:
 - Do not extend hands, arms, head, or objects through bus windows.
 - If you open a window, make sure it is closed when you're finished.
- Conduct:
 - Fighting, bullying, or cyberbullying are strictly prohibited.
 - No eating, drinking, or chewing gum on the bus (only water is allowed).
 - No glass, tobacco, vape products, weapons, reptiles, animals, or insects on the bus.

• Personal Belongings:

- Keep all personal possessions (including cell phones and electronic devices) in your backpack or pockets.
- \circ No playing music or audio without headphones.
- Property Respect:
 - Vandalism is prohibited. Do not damage the bus or personal property.

These rules are designed to keep everyone safe and maintain a respectful environment on the bus. It's important for students to follow them at all times.
