Important Information:

- If you currently reside outside of district boundaries an <u>open enrollment application</u> is required.
- All students are required to attend state testing in the spring
- In-person final exams are required for all secondary (7-12) students.
- Students are required to log their time and submit weekly timesheets. Students not logging 25 hours per week will be withdrawn from the program.

Is it too late to enroll in our online learning program?

No, students can join our program at any time before the semester 1 and semester 2 cut-off dates. QCUSD follows the school district calendar for school days, breaks, and holidays.

What educational platform do we use?

We use a program called Edgenuity. However, we do have certified teachers on staff to support our students with social, emotional, and academic needs.

Is there a certain time students have to sign on each day?

No, our program is self-paced. Our teachers do offer optional small group support and enrichment activities. Students are required to stay on pace weekly or they will be removed from the program.

Will the seniors participate in the graduation ceremony or prom at their home school?

No, our seniors will not participate in the home school graduation ceremony. Students will receive a "Queen Creek Virtual Academy" diploma and QCVA is planning a separate celebration for seniors. QCVA students must attend prom as a guest.

Can students still participate in extracurricular activities?

QCVA students can only participate in athletic sports at their home school that takes place outside of the school day.

- Successful completion of the New Civics Test Requirement

- Board Policy requires freshmen, sophomores, and juniors to enroll in six courses. Graduating seniors will be required to enroll in a minimum of five credit earning courses.
