**Thrive Student Workbook** is up for Supplementary Materials adoption. Per Policy 5-207, this workbook will be placed on display in the District Office for a period of at least sixty (60) days prior to the meeting at which the Board will consider its adoption.

Per A.R.S. 15-154, the School Safety Program is established within the Arizona Department of Education to support, promote, and enhance safe and effective learning environments for all students by supporting the costs of placing school resource officers (SROs) on school campuses. The School Safety Program is a competitive, state-funded grant that runs in three-year cycles. Each QCUSD high school was awarded funding for a SRO in the new grant cycle, which begins in the 2023-24 school year. Per the intergovernmental agreement (IGA) between the City of Mesa and QCUSD, SROs provide law related education (LRE).

A 60-day review of the THRIVE student workbook as a supplementary resource is requested to assist with meeting instructional requirements for the grant. The request for a 60-day review is for the student workbook only, excluding chapter two. Digital access to supplementary curriculum is not part of the request. Parent permission will be obtained for all students receiving LRE.
